
Accountability




In 2022,

- 5% higher income with 1.2% higher expenses resulted in better net income
- DRBA received more funding in donations compared to 2021
- Lower grant income was offset by other and new income sources
- DRBA spent less than 20% of donations on staff training, marketing and administration

Highlights

- More than 8,000 youth were reached by DRBA's EE programs
- 12 miles of river were cleaned and monitored
- 6 miles of trail were cleaned of litter and debris
- More than 300 trees were planted along waterways as riparian buffer
